
Referring to the BOCS Foundation's 2015-2016 CO₂e-emission prevention reports, its appendices and annexes, the calculations based on them, and the results of the 2018 report

2015: 27 476 tCO₂e

2016: 13 204 tCO₂e

totaling: 40 680 tCO₂e emission prevention figure is the consequence of the expenses of the BOCS Foundation's projects stated in the annexes, which are also published in the financial reports. I have checked the related calculations, and they are well-founded and correct.

The sums of these expenses have reached their environmental goals the way it was described in the report, and are suitable for the VCUs (Voluntary Carbon Units) to be listed at the registrar in order to create QFPC™, with respect to 40 680 minus the already registered 17 433, or a total of 23 247 (VCU).
